SECTION A - SUPPLEMENTAL INFORMATION

1. THE PURPOSE OF THIS AMENDMENT 0001 IS TO:

A. DELETE PARAGRAPH 11, PAGE 2, OF THE SOLICITATION IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REPLACE WITH THE FOLLOWING PARAGRAPH 11:

11. All delivery orders will be issued unilaterally by the government. Delivery orders will specify the destination and delivery date. Upon award, Delivery Order 0001 will be placed for the First Article Test - Contractor, and at least the guaranteed minimum contract order quantity. The delivery schedule for Delivery Order 0001 requires first article testing and submittal of the first article test report 60 days after award. Delivery of production quantities placed on Delivery Order 0001 shall commence 30 days after approval of first article at a rate of at least 25 sets per month. Subsequent delivery orders will be for production quantities and will not include the price for First Article Test. Deliveries beginning with Delivery Order 0002 shall commence within 30 days after receipt of electronic/facsimile delivery order at a rate of at least 25 sets per month. Early deliveries are authorized if made at no additional cost to the government.

B. CHANGE 3RD SENTANCE OF PARAGRAPH 3.3.2.1 DRAWERS, OF DFP 404 DATED 09 SEP 2002, AS FOLLOWS:

To minimize the possibility that small piece parts will be dislodged from their storage locations during transport, the back and sidewalls of each drawer shall have a height at least 80% of, and preferably equal to, the drawer's useable storage height.

C. FOR PURPOSES OF CLARIFICATION, INCORPORATE THE FOLLOWING SOLICITATION QUESTIONS, ANSWERS, AND ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. Q: Please clarify the exact meaning of the term "set" as used in the solicitation.

A: As stated in paragraph 1.1 of the DFP, "This specification describes a Spare Part Storage Set consisting of transportable storage cabinets that will fit within a designated space in an Army tactical cargo truck." Further, as stated in paragraph 3.3.1.1, "The set will be installed inside a tactical cargo truck with interior dimensions of 88 inches wide, and 147 inches long."

The term "set" as used in this solicitation means all cabinets required to outfit one tactical cargo truck.

2. Q: Please clarify the requirement for the back and sidewalls of each drawer to have a height of at least 90% of the drawers useable storage height.

A: Per Amendment 0001 to the solicitation (see para B above), paragraph 3.3.2.1 Drawers, of DFP 404, is changed to: "... the back and sidewalls of each drawer shall have a height of at least 80% of, and preferably equal to, the drawers useable storage height."

3. Additional Information: The sides can be removed from the cargo truck to facilitate the loading and unloading of cabinets.

2. THE DATE FOR RECEIPT OF OFFERS REMAINS AT 12 NOV 2002.

3. ALL OTHER TERMS AND CONDITIONS REMAIN THE SAME.
