

EVALUATION CRITERIA--PRICE

SECTION L. PRICE

1. The offeror will enter unit prices for each ordering period for all items listed on the Price Evaluation Spreadsheets (Attachment 001). The offeror will also enter a First Article Test (FAT) cost in the spaces provided on the price evaluation spreadsheets for Items 0001 and 0002. All unit prices will be binding.
2. The Government reserves the right to require the submission of any data necessary to validate the reasonableness of an offer.

SECTION M. PRICE

1. The Government will consider the total price of each item in evaluating offers for award purposes, as shown below, including First Article Test costs (unless waived) and Transportation cost.

2. The weighted evaluated price will be calculated by summing the multiplication of each range's unit price by the weight and the maximum quantity of the range, for each item. For evaluation purposes, the Government has weighted the ranges based on the likelihood that if an order is placed, it will be placed in that range. The Evaluated Price for each item is the sum of the weighted evaluation price for each ordering period. The Total Evaluated Price for all Items is the sum of the Evaluated Price for each item.
3. The Evaluated First Article Test (FAT) Cost will be the sum of the FAT cost for Items 0001 and 0002, unless it has been determined that the FAT cost will be waived.
4. If an offeror takes exception to or fails to propose any of the ranges in each ordering period, or First Article Test, the Government may reject that offer as unacceptable.
5. If it is determined that First Article Test will not be waived, the cost for First Article Test will be amortized in the unit price on the initial delivery order.
6. Since proposed prices will be on a F.O.B. Origin basis, projected transportation costs will be evaluated. In accordance with the shipping plan, items may be shipped to three different destinations, Anniston, AL, Tracy, CA, or New Cumberland, PA. For evaluation purposes, the estimated transportation cost will be computed based on the guaranteed minimum quantity for

Items 0001, 0003 and 0004, from each offerors shipping point to each of the three possible destinations. The three destinations will be weighted based on the likelihood that the items will be shipped to that destination. The Total Evaluated Transportation Cost will be the sum of the transportation cost for all items containing the guaranteed minimum quantity.
