

SCOPE OF WORK

1. The Government has a requirement for two mock-ups, one for the M1A1D tank and one for the M1A2 SEP tank. The M1A1-D is a modified M1A1 Abrams Main Battle Tank and the M1A2 SEP is the latest version of the Abrams Tank family. The Government wants to show and demonstrate the mock-ups. The mock-up for the M1A1D tank is required for the Ordnance Conference in Aberdeen on May 10 - 13, 2000, and the mock-up for the M1A2 SEP tank is required for the AUSA Conference in Washington, D.C. on October 4 - 6, 2000.
2. The Contractor shall provide personnel and all necessary labor to fabricate the Mock-Up of the M1A1-D tank and the M1A2 SEP tank systems as specified by paragraphs no. 4 and 5 below. Also, the contractor shall provide personnel and labor to assist in the assembly and testing of the each Mock-Up. After testing of each mock-up, the contractor shall make any necessary changes to the mock-up.
3. The Government shall provide all material and equipment, including test equipment, for this effort. The contractor shall assist the Government with all testing.
4. The Contractor shall fabricate the Mock-Up for the M1A1-D tank systems and the Mock-UP for the M1A2 SEP tank systems in accordance with the drawings provided under separate cover and incorporated by reference into this purchase order.
5. The Mock-Ups shall be made of steel. The Mock-Ups shall be fabricated and assembled in such a manner, that they will operate, function, and look exactly like the existing Mock-Ups located in the Maintenance Operations and Procedure (MOP Shop) located in Building 110 at the Rock Island Arsenal. These existing mock-ups will be available to the contractor during performance of this scope of work. The Contractor shall perform all work at the MOP Shop.
6. The MOP Shop shall be available for the Contractor's use from award of this purchase order until 30 Sep 2000, from 0600 (6:00 am) until 1630 (4:30 pm), Monday through Friday.
7. Inspection and Acceptance will be performed by the Contracting Officers Technical Representative (COTR) for this effort shall be Michael W. Williams, Chief, MOP Shop.
