Sites and number of Sensors

Each site is provided with a fixed number of sensors, which comprised of operational sensors and spare sensors. The number of operational and spare sensors is site dependent and is listed below. Although the sensors are powered on 24 hours a day, the sensor network is typically active for 12 hours a day during the evening hours. During high threat conditions, the sensors will be activated as required.
