1. This solicitation will result in the award of a long-term, firm fixed price, requirements type contract for Fuel Injection Test Stand (FITS) Systems, NSN: 4910-01-465-4537. The FITS systems shall meet or exceed the requirements set forth in Description for Purchase (DFP) 390-2, included herein as Attachment 1. The North American Industrial Classification System (NAICS) Code is 811198/ \$6 Million.
2. The Government is offering existing FITS systems, Bacharach Model A8020, for exchange in accordance with solicitation clause 252.217-7002, Offering Property for Exchange, included herein as Attachment 2. These systems are offered on an as-is basis and without warranty. For delivery orders based on an exchange, the Government will furnish one Bacharach Model A8020 for every unit ordered. Offerors will be provided an opportunity to examine a Bacharach Model A8020 system at a pre-proposal conference, however, the Government makes no representation or guarantee that the Bacharach Model A8020 FITS systems to be furnished under this contract will be of like or similar condition.
3. The pre-proposal conference will be held to address questions and to provide offerors an opportunity to view a Bacharach Model A8020 FITS. The conference is scheduled for May 30, 2002 at 9:00 a.m. central standard time and will be held at the Rock Island Arsenal, Rock Island, Illinois, Building 104, 1st Floor, NAMI Conference Room. 4. Deliveries, First Delivery Order Only: The Contractor shall perform product verification testing on the first unit to be delivered under this contract and submit to the Contracting Officer a Product Verification Test Report for approval in accordance with Attachment 6, PRODUCT VERIFICATION TESTING (CONTRACTOR TESTING). The report shall be submitted with 150 calendar days of the first order placed under this contract. Once the report is approved, the Contractor shall complete the order. At a minimum, the Contractor shall begin deliveries within 90 days of the Government's approval at rate of 3 units per month, unless the order quantity or remaining quantity is less than 3, in which case the entire quantity shall be delivered. If the order is based on an exchange of Bacharach Model A8020 FITS systems, the Government shall begin furnishing these systems to the Contractor at a rate of 3 units per month from the date of the order, unless the order quantity or remaining quantity is less than 3, in which case the entire quantity shall be furnished.

After completing the directed action and upon written request of the Contractor, the Contracting Officer shall make an equitable adjustment as provided in paragraph (h) of this clause.

Unless otherwise provided in this contract, the Contractor assume the risk of, and shall be responsible for, any loss or destruction of, or damage to, Government property upon its delivery to the Contractor or upon passage of title to the Government under paragraph (c) of this clause. However, the Contractor is not responsible for reasonable wear and tear to Government property or for Government property properly consumed in performing this contract.

h. Equitable adjustment. When this clause specifies an equitable adjustment, it shall be made to any affected contract provision in accordance with the procedures of the Change clause. When appropriate, the Contracting Officer may initiate an equitable adjustment in favor of the Government. The right to an equitable adjustment shall be the Contractor's exclusive remedy. The Government shall not be liable to suit for breach of contract for -

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- (1) Any delay in delivery of Government-furnished property;
- (2) Delivery of Government-furnished property in a condition not suitable for its intended use;
- (3) A decrease in or substitution of Government-furnished property; or
- (4) Failure to repair or replace Government property for which the Government is responsible.

i. Final accounting and disposition of Government property. Upon completing this contract, or at such earlier dates as may be fixed by the Contracting Officer, the Contractor shall submit, in a form acceptable to the Contracting Officer, inventory schedules covering all items of Government property (including any resulting scrap) not consumed in performing this contract or delivered to the Government. The Contractor shall prepare for shipment, deliver f.o.b. origin, or dispose of the Government property as may be directed or authorized by the Contracting Officer. The net proceeds of any such disposal shall be credited to the contract price or shall be paid to the Government as the Contracting Officer directs.

j. Abandonment and restoration of Contractor's premises. Unless otherwise provided herein, the Government -

(1) May abandon any Government property in place, at which time all obligations of the Government regarding such abandoned property shall cease; and

(2) Has no obligation to restore or rehabilitate the Contractor's premises under any circumstances (e.g., abandonment, disposition upon completion of need, or upon contract completion). However, if the Government-furnished property (listed in the Schedule or specifications) is withdrawn or is unsuitable for the intended use, or if other Government property is substituted, then the equitable adjustment under paragraph (h) of this clause may properly include restoration or rehabilitation costs.

k. Communications. All communications under this clause shall be in writing.

l. Overseas contracts. If this contract is to be performed outside of the United States of America, its territories, or possessions, the words "Government" and "Government-furnished" (wherever they appear in this clause) shall be construed as "United States Government" and "United States Government-furnished," respectively.
