

PRICE SUBMISSION & EVALUATION

SECTION L. PRICE

1. The offeror will enter unit prices for each ordering period for all quantities for all CLINs and First Article Test Cost on the Price Evaluation Spreadsheet. All unit prices will be binding.
2. The Government reserves the right to require the submission of any data necessary to validate the reasonableness of an offer.

SECTION M. PRICE

1. The Government will evaluate offers based on the proposed prices for all ordering periods and any other price related factors required by the solicitation.
2. The Evaluated Price will be calculated by summing the multiplication of the proposed unit price by its respective weight and maximum quantity of each range for a given ordering period and adding the totals for all periods. If First Article Test (FAT) costs are applicable they will be included to obtain the total evaluated price. If a FAT is required, the cost will be amortized into the unit price for the initial delivery order only.
3. For purposes of evaluation, the Government has weighted the ranges based on the likelihood that if an order is placed, it will be placed in that range.
4. If an offeror takes exception to or fails to propose unit prices for all quantity ranges and ordering periods and/or FAT, the offeror may be disqualified.
