THE CHARACTERISTICS (1 & 2) ON THE SQAP FOR EACH OF THESE DIMENSIONS SHOULD HAVE A RUN OUT OF .002 INSTEAD OF .001. SO THE DRAWING TAKES PRECEDENCE OVER THE SQAP FOR THE RUN OUT TOLERANCE REQUIRED AND THESE DIMENSIONS SHOULD BE INSPECTED ACCORDINGLY. AN ECP WILL BE INITIATED TO UPDATE THE SQAP.
