e. Delivery of the items added by exercise of this option shall continue immediately after, and at the same rate as delivery of like items called for under the contract, unless the parties agree otherwise.

f. Subject to the limitations contained in this clause, the Government may exercise this option on one or more occasions.

EVALUATION OF OPTIONS
